Classes	Topics
Class 1 & 2	“Water Warriors” –Students will learn and observe the ways to conserve water through action songs, poems, stories, fun activities etc
Class 3, 4,& 5	“Planet Pal Squad!” Students will learn and observe the use of blue /green bins. Initiate and involve in keeping their surrounding clean ,conserve resources, providing water and food for small animals ,making of bird feeder by using waste material, watering plants. Visit to old age home, Community kitchen (Class 3 only), Compost pit
Class 6 & 7	“Roots, Wings, and Wonders- Students will learn about Indigenous foods like millets(Roots of India), Exploring diversity and Uncovering nature's hidden treasure(wings and wonders), Shri Anna(eat local, avoid carbon footprints) through documentaries, role plays and discussion,
Class 8	“Hands on learning” on theme- Water, Food and natural resources through bridge programme as per CBSE planner. Importance of balance food, Health and hygiene while preparing food (Poshan Abhiyan), Quiz, discussion on current event
Class 9 & 10	Circle of Thoughts- Guftgu - A reflective, thought-provoking discussion between students and inspiring change-makers from different genres to spark deeper thinking and fresh perspectives.
